

Verbenas

Most garden-type verbenas are too wimpy for our summers, but a few have performed very well for us over the years. Undoubtedly the best is 'St. Paul Pink.' 'Tapien Blue-Violet' is a low-growing variety that also does well. Verbenas even under the best of conditions will "cycle" in and out of bloom. Consistently moist soil, rather than periods of wet and dry, seems to help moderate this problem somewhat.
